## A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF COOLING OFF PERIOD.
- 4 With respect to the labor dispute between the Pacific
- 5 Maritime Association and the International Longshore
- 6 and Warehouse Union, the cooling off period provided for
- 7 in the order of the district court in the case of United
- 8 States of America v. Pacific Maritime Association, and
- 9 International Longshore and Warehouse Union pursuant
- 10 to the petition of the Attorney General (as provided for

- 1 in section 208 of the Labor Management Relations Act,
- $2~1947~(29~\mathrm{U.S.C.}~178))$  shall be extended for an additional

3 30 days.
