Mr. DOMENICI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

Making an urgent supplemental appropriation for fiscal year 2001 for the Department of Defense for the Defense Health Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Urgent Defense Health
5 Appropriation Act, 2001”.

6 **SEC. 2. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.**

7 The following sum is appropriated, out of any money
8 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to provide a
9 supplemental appropriation for the Department of Defense
10 for fiscal year 2001:

1 DEFENSE HEALTH PROGRAM

2 For an additional amount for “Defense Health Pro-
3 gram”, \$1,200,000,000, for expenses, not otherwise pro-
4 vided for, for medical and health care services for mem-
5 bers of the uniformed services, retired members and
6 former members of the uniformed services, and their de-
7 pendents for TRICARE and other medical and health care
8 expenses, as authorized by law, to remain available until
9 expended.
