To amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, to increase the maximum term of imprisonment for offenses involving stolen firearms.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. STOLEN FIREARMS.
4	(a) In General.—Section 924 of title 18, United
5	States Code, is amended—
6	(1) in subsection (a)—
7	(A) in paragraph (2), by striking "(i),
8	(j),"; and

(B) by adding at the end the following:

1	"(7) Whoever knowingly violates subsection (i)
2	or (j) of section 922 shall be fined under this title,
3	imprisoned not more than 15 years, or both.";
4	(2) in subsection (i)(1), by striking "10 years"
5	and inserting "15 years"; and
6	(3) in subsection (l), by striking "10 years" and
7	inserting "15 years".
8	(b) Sentencing Commission.—The United States
9	Sentencing Commission shall amend the Federal sen-
10	tencing guidelines to reflect the amendments made by sub-
11	section (a)
