## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to reduce the tax on vaccines to 25 cents per dose.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Vaccinate America's
- 5 Children Now Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REDUCTION IN TAX ON VACCINES.
- 7 (a) In General.—Paragraph (1) of section 4131(b)
- 8 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to amount
- 9 of tax) is amended by striking "75 cents" and inserting
- 10 "25 cents".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
- 3 ment of this Act.
- 4 (c) Limitation on Certain Credits or Re-
- 5 FUNDS.—For purposes of applying section 4132(b) of the
- 6 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 with respect to any claim
- 7 for credit or refund filed before January 1, 2002, the
- 8 amount of tax taken into account shall not exceed the tax
- 9 computed under the rate in effect on the day after the
- 10 date of the enactment of this Act.
