A BILL

To provide wage parity for certain Department of Defense prevailing rate employees in Georgia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. WAGE PARITY FOR CERTAIN DEPARTMENT OF
4 DEFENSE EMPLOYEES IN GEORGIA

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The wage schedules and rates ap-
6 plicable to prevailing rate employees (as defined in section
7 5342 of title 5, United States Code) of the Department
8 of Defense in the Macon, Georgia, wage area shall be the
9 same as the wage schedules and rates applicable to pre-

1 vailing rate employees of the Department of Defense in
2 the Atlanta, Georgia, wage area.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) shall take ef-
4 feet beginning with the first pay period beginning on or
5 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
