A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to provide separate subheadings for hair clippers used for animals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HAIR CLIPPERS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 8510 of chapter 85 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking subheading 8510.20.00 and in-
8 serting the following, with the article description for
9 subheading 8510.20 having the same degree of in-
10 dentation as the article description for subheading

1 8510.10.00, and with the article descriptions for
 2 subheadings 8510.20.10 and 8510.20.90 having the
 3 same degree of indentation as the article description
 4 for subheading 8510.90.55:

" 8510.20	Hair clippers:					
8510.20.10	Hair clippers for animals for use on the farm	4%	Free (A,CA,E, IL,J,MX)	45%		
8510.20.90	Other	4%	Free (A,CA,E, IL,J,MX)	45%		”;

6 (2) by striking subheading 8510.90.30 and inserting the following subheadings and superior text thereto, with such superior text having the same degree of indentation as the article description for subheading 8510.90.55:

" 8510.90.30	Parts of hair clippers:					
8510.90.40	For animals for use on the farm	4%	Free (A,CA,E, IL,J,MX)	45%		
8510.90.40	Other	4%	Free (A,CA,E, IL,J,MX)	45%		”;

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 12 this section shall apply with respect to articles entered,
 13 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 14 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
