## A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE HEADSTONES OR
- 4 MARKERS FOR MARKED GRAVES OR OTHER-
- 5 WISE COMMEMORATE CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS.
- 6 (a) In General.—Section 2306 of title 38, United
- 7 States Code, is amended—

1 (1) in subsections (a) and (e)(1), by striking 2 "the unmarked graves of"; and 3 (2) by adding at the end the following: 4 "(f) A headstone or marker furnished under sub-5 section (a) shall be furnished, upon request, for the 6 marked grave or unmarked grave of the individual or at another area appropriate for the purpose of commemo-7 8 rating the individual.". 9 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment to subsection (a) of section 2306 of title 38, United States Code, made 10 by subsection (a) of this section, and subsection (f) of such
