## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to maintain exemption of Alaska from dyeing requirements for exempt diesel fuel and kerosene.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ALASKA EXEMPTION FROM DYEING REQUIRE-**  
4       **MENTS.**

5       (a) EXCEPTION TO DYEING REQUIREMENTS FOR EX-  
6       EMPT DIESEL FUEL AND KEROSENE.—Paragraph (1) of  
7       section 4082(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (re-  
8       lating to exception to dyeing requirements) is amended to  
9       read as follows:

1           “(1) removed, entered, or sold in the State of  
2       Alaska for ultimate sale or use in such State, and”.

3       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
4 this section applies with respect to fuel removed, entered,  
5 or sold on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
