A BILL

To designate 7 counties in the State of Montana as High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas and authorize funding for drug control activities in those areas.

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAF-**
4 **FICKING AREAS IN MONTANA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other
6 provision of law, for purposes of the high intensity
7 drug trafficking areas program established under
8 section 707 of the Office of National Drug Control
9 Policy Reauthorization Act of 1988 (21 U.S.C.

1 1706), the counties of Yellowstone, Missoula, Cas-
2 cade, Flathead, Lincoln, Custer, and Dawson in the
3 State of Montana are each designated as High In-
4 tensity Drug Trafficking Areas and shall be part of
5 the Rocky Mountain High Intensity Drug Traf-
6 ficking Area.

7 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

8 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
9 as are necessary for each of fiscal years 2002
10 through 2006 to carry out drug control activities in
11 the areas designated by this section.

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
