- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1861(s)(2)(Q) of the So-
- 9 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(2)(Q)) is amended

- 1 by striking "chemotherapeutic agent for a given indica-
- 2 tion," and all that follows and inserting "agent for a medi-
- 3 cally accepted indication (as defined in subsection
- 4 (t)(2)(B));".
- 5 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Section
- 6 1834(j)(5)(F)(iv) of such Act (42 U.S.C.
- 7 1395m(j)(5)(F)(iv)) is amended by striking "therapeutic".
- 8 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 9 this section shall apply with respect to drugs furnished
- 10 on or after the date that is 90 days after the date of the
- 11 enactment of this Act.
