- 6 (a) In General.—Section 320(a)(3) of the Immi-
- 7 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1431(a)(3)) is
- 8 amended by inserting before the period the following: ",

- 1 or is residing abroad in the legal and physical custody of
- 2 a citizen parent who is serving in a military or other Gov-
- 3 ernment position abroad".
- 4 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 5 subsection (a) shall apply to children adopted before, on,
- 6 or after the date of enactment of this Act.
