4 *dent pro tempore of the Senate, the Chaplain of the House*
5 *of Representatives and the Chaplain of the Senate shall*
6 *conduct a joint assembly, to be conducted in the House*
7 *Chamber, in which Members of the House of Representa-*
8 *tives and the Senate will be able to express the past strug-*
9 *gles that we as a Nation have experienced, overcome, and*
10 *still struggle with, and thereby lead the Nation in begin-*
11 *ning the process of reconciliation.*
