CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress that public schools may
display the words “God Bless America” as an expression
of support for the Nation.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that it is
3 consistent with the Constitution for public schools to dis-
4 play the words “God Bless America” as an expression of
5 support for the Nation.
