Whereas Elizabeth B. Letchworth has dutifully served the
United States Senate for over 25 years;

Whereas Elizabeth's service to the Senate began with her ap-
pointment as a United States Senate page in 1975;

Whereas Elizabeth continued her work as a special Legisla-
tive assistant, a Republican Cloakroom assistant, and as
a Republican Floor Assistant;

Whereas in 1995 Elizabeth was appointed by the Majority
Leader and elected by the Senate to be Secretary for the
Majority;

Whereas Elizabeth was the first woman to be elected as Re-
publican Secretary; and

Whereas Elizabeth was the youngest person to be elected the Secretary for the Majority at the age of 34: Now, therefore, be it

3 United States Senate, and wishes to express its deep ap-
4 preciation and gratitude for her contributions to the insti-
