RESOLUTION

Authorizing the taking of a photograph in the Chamber
of the United States Senate.

1 *Resolved*, That paragraph 1 of rule IV of the Rules
2 for the Regulation of the Senate Wing of the United
3 States Capitol (prohibiting the taking of pictures in the
4 Senate Chamber) be temporarily suspended for the sole
5 and specific purpose of permitting the Senate Photo-
6 graphic Studio to photograph the United States Senate
7 in actual session on Wednesday, January 23, 2002, at the
8 hour of 2:30 p.m.

9 SEC. 2. The Sergeant at Arms of the Senate is au-
10 thorized and directed to make the necessary arrangements

- 1 therefor, which arrangements shall provide for a minimum
- 2 of disruption to Senate proceedings.
