## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of  
Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment  
of the Senate.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Thursday, February 13, 2003, or Friday, Feb-  
4 ruary 14, 2003, on a motion offered pursuant to this con-  
5 current resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee,  
6 it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, February 25,  
7 2003, or until Members are notified to reassemble pursu-  
8 ant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever  
9 occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses or ad-  
10 journs on Thursday, February 13, 2003, Friday, February

1 14, 2003, Saturday, February 15, 2003, or any day from  
2 Monday, February 17, 2003, through Friday, February  
3 21, 2003, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent  
4 resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand  
5 recessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, February 24,  
6 2003, or at such other time on that day as may be speci-  
7 fied by its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion  
8 to recess or adjourn, or until Members are notified to reas-  
9 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,  
10 whichever occurs first.

11       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
12 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting  
13 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
14 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify  
15 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,  
16 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-  
17 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall  
18 warrant it.
