CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, May 20, 2004, or Friday, May 21,
4 2004, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, June
5 1, 2004, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to

1 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
2 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on
3 Thursday, May 20, 2004, Friday, May 21, 2004, or Satur-
4 day, May 22, 2004, on a motion offered pursuant to this
5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
6 ignee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tues-
7 day, June 1, 2004, or at such other time on that day as
8 may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee
9 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of
10 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
11 resolution, whichever occurs first.

12 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
13 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
14 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
15 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
16 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
17 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
18 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall
19 warrant it.
