- 5 1, 2004, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to

- 1 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
- 2 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on
- 3 Thursday, May 20, 2004, Friday, May 21, 2004, or Satur-
- 4 day, May 22, 2004, on a motion offered pursuant to this
- 5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
- 6 ignee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tues-
- 7 day, June 1, 2004, or at such other time on that day as
- 8 may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee
- 9 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of
- 10 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
- 11 resolution, whichever occurs first.
- 12 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 13 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
- 14 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
- 15 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
- 16 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
- 17 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
- 18 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall
- 19 warrant it.
