CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, July 22, 2004, or Friday, July 23,
4 2004, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
5 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand

1 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, September 7, 2004,
 2 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section
 3 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and
 4 that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on Thursday,
 5 July 22, 2004, Friday, July 23, 2004, or Saturday, July
 6 24, 2004, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent
 7 resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
 8 recessed or adjourned until noon on Tuesday, September
 9 7, 2004, or at such other time on that day as may be
 10 specified by its Majority Leader or his designee in the mo-
 11 tion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any re-
 12 assembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-
 13 tion, whichever occurs first.

14 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
 15 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
 16 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
 17 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
 18 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
 19 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
 20 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall
 21 warrant it.
