CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring), That when the House adjourns on the legisla-*
3 *tive day of Wednesday, January 8, 2003, Thursday, Janu-*
4 *ary 9, 2003, or Friday, January 10, 2003, on a motion*
5 *offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its*

1 Majority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until
2 2 p.m. on Monday, January 27, 2003, or until Members
3 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this
4 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that
5 when the Senate recesses or adjourns on any day from
6 Thursday, January 9, 2003, through Friday, January 24,
7 2003, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
8 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
9 recessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, January 27,
10 2003, or at such other time on that day as may be speci-
11 fied by its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion
12 to recess or adjourn, or until Members are notified to reas-
13 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
14 whichever occurs first.

15 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
16 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
17 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
18 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
19 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
20 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

- 1 designate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest
- 2 shall warrant it.
