JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relating to marriage.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States:

1 "ARTICLE —

2 "SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 3 "This Article may be cited as the 'Marriage Protec-
- 4 tion Amendment'.

5 "SECTION 2. MARRIAGE AMENDMENT.

- 6 "Marriage in the United States shall consist solely
- 7 of the union of a man and a woman. Neither this Constitu-
- 8 tion, nor the constitution of any State, shall be construed
- 9 to require that marriage or the legal incidents thereof be
- 10 conferred upon any union other than the union of a man
- 11 and a woman.".
