Mr. CANTOR introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To limit the period of validity of driver's licenses and State identification cards issued to nonimmigrant aliens to the period of validity of nonimmigrant visas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Drivers’ License Integ-
5 rity Act of 2003”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF DRIVER'S**
2 **LICENSES AND STATE IDENTIFICATION**
3 **CARDS ISSUED TO NONIMMIGRANT ALIENS**
4 **TO THE PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF NON-**
5 **IMMIGRANT VISAS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
7 sion of law, a valid nonimmigrant visa is required for a
8 nonimmigrant alien to obtain a driver's license or State
9 identification card in the United States and a driver's li-
10 cense or State identification card issued in the United
11 States to a nonimmigrant alien shall be valid only during
12 the period of validity of the alien's nonimmigrant visa.

13 (b) AUTHORITY OF SECRETARY OF HOMELAND SE-
14 CURITY.—The Secretary of Homeland Security shall enter
15 into such discussions with appropriate officials of State
16 and local governments regarding the issuance of driver's
17 licenses and State identification cards as are necessary
18 and appropriate to ensure prompt and efficient compliance
19 with the limitation under subsection (a).

20 **SEC. 3. GRANT PROGRAM.**

21 The Secretary of Homeland Security shall establish
22 a program of grants to assist States in issuing appropriate
23 licenses and identification documents consistent with the
24 requirements of this Act.
