A BILL

To provide grants to law enforcement agencies to use iris scanning technology to conduct background checks on individuals who want to purchase guns.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Iris Scan Security Act
- 5 of 2003".
- 6 SEC. 2. GRANT PROGRAM.
- 7 The Attorney General may award grants to law en-
- 8 forcement agencies to use iris scanning technology to con-
- 9 duct background checks on individuals who want to pur-
- 10 chase guns.

1 SEC. 3. APPLICATION.

- 2 To request a grant under this Act, the chief officer
- 3 of a law enforcement agency shall submit an application
- 4 to the Attorney General in such form and containing such
- 5 information as the Attorney General may reasonably re-
- 6 quire.

7 SEC. 4. DEFINITION.

- 8 For purposes of this Act, the term "gun" means a
- 9 firearm (as defined in section 921(a)(3) of title 18, United
- 10 States Code).

11 SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- There are authorized to carry out this Act such sums
- 13 as may be necessary for each of fiscal years 2004 through
- 14 2008.
