3 **SECTION 1. INTERSTATE ROUTE I-35 HIGH PRIORITY COR-**
4 **RIDOR.**

5 Section 1105(c)(23) of the Intermodal Surface
6 Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (105 Stat. 2032)
7 is amended by inserting before the period at the end the
8 following: “and the connection from Wichita, Kansas, to
9 Sioux City, Iowa, which includes I-135 from Wichita,

1 Kansas to Salina, Kansas, United States Route 81 from
2 Saline, Kansas, to Norfolk, Nebraska, Nebraska State
3 Route 35 from Norfolk, Nebraska, to South Sioux City,
4 Nebraska, and the connection to I-29 in Sioux City,
5 Iowa”.
