- 3 SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN PILOT-TRAINING
- 4 BASES FROM 2005 BASE CLOSURE ROUND.
- 5 Section 2914(b) of the Defense Base Closure and Re-
- 6 alignment Act of 1990, as added by section 3003 of the
- 7 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2002

- 1 (Public Law 107–107; 115 Stat. 1345), is amended by
- 2 adding at the end the following new paragraph:
- 3 "(3) Exemption of undergraduate pilot-
- 4 Training bases.—The recommendations of the Sec-
- 5 retary and the recommendations of the Commission
- 6 regarding the closure or adverse realignment of mili-
- 7 tary installations may not include any military in-
- 8 stallation used for undergraduate pilot training.".
