SECTION 1. EMERGENCY ADJUSTMENT IN BASIC ALLOW ANCE FOR HOUSING RATES. Section 403(b)(4) of title 37, United States Code, is amended—

5 (1) by striking "An adjustment" and inserting
6 "(A) Except as provided in subparagraph (B), an
7 adjustment"; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-9 paragraph:

10 "(B) The Secretary may provide an emergency ad-11 justment in the rates of the basic allowance for housing for a particular military housing area in response to a sud-12 13 den increase in housing costs in the area as a result of higher charges for utilities or other causes. An adjustment 14 in the rates of the basic allowance for housing under the 15 16 authority of this subparagraph may take effect in advance 17 of the effective date specified in subparagraph (A), and, notwithstanding paragraph (6), shall remain in effect for 18 19 a period determined by the Secretary, but not to exceed 20 six months. The Secretary shall provide written notice to 21 Congress of any rate adjustment made under this sub-22 paragraph and the reasons for the adjustment.".
