A BILL

To establish a program to provide funds for deployment of fuel cell and hydrogen infrastructure at National Parks, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “The National Parks
5 Fuel Cell and Hydrogen Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FUEL CELLS AT NATIONAL PARKS.**

7 The Secretary of Energy, in cooperation with the Sec-
8 retary of Interior and the National Park Service, is au-

1 thorized to establish a program to provide funds to assist
2 in the deployment of fuel cell and hydrogen infrastructure
3 at one or more prominent National Parks. The Secretary
4 of Energy shall transmit to Congress within 1 year, and
5 annually thereafter, a report describing any activities
6 taken pursuant to such program. The report shall address
7 whether activities taken pursuant to such program reduce
8 the environmental impacts of energy use at National
9 Parks. There are authorized to be appropriated \$2 million
10 for each of fiscal years 2004 through 2010 to carry out
11 the purposes of this section.
