1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Selected Reserve Edu-
3	cational Assistance Improvement Act".
4	SEC. 2. INCREASE IN AMOUNT OF BASIC EDUCATIONAL AS-
5	SISTANCE.
б	(a) IN GENERAL.—(1) Paragraph (1) of Section
7	16131(b) of title 10, United States Code, is amended—
8	(A) in subparagraph (A), by striking " $$251$ "
9	and inserting "\$600";
10	(B) in subparagraph (B), by striking "\$188"
11	and inserting "\$450"; and
12	(C) in subparagraph (C), by striking " $$125$ "
13	and inserting "\$300".
14	(2) The amendments made by paragraph (1) shall
15	take effect on October 1, 2004, and shall apply with re-
16	spect to educational assistance allowances under section
17	16131(b)(1) of such title paid for months after September
18	2004.
19	(3) In the case of an educational assistance allowance
20	under such section paid for months occuring during fiscal
21	year 2004—
22	(A) subparagraph (A) of such section shall be
23	applied by substituting "\$475" for "\$251";
24	(B) subparagraph (B) of such section shall be
25	applied by substituting "\$325" for "\$188"; and

(C) subparagraph (C) of such section shall be
 applied by substituting "\$215" for "\$125".

3 (b) NO ADJUSTMENT FOR FISCAL YEARS 2004 AND
4 2005.—Section 16131(b)(2) of such title shall not apply
5 to rates of basic educational assistance paid under such
6 section during fiscal years 2004 and 2005.

7 SEC. 3. APPLICATION OF INDEX BASED ON COSTS OF HIGH8 ER LEARNING.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 16131(b)(2) of title 10,
10 United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

11 "(2)(A) With respect to any fiscal year beginning on 12 or after October 1, 2004, the Secretary shall provide a 13 percentage increase (rounded to the nearest dollar) in the 14 rates payable under paragraph (1) equal to the percentage 15 (as determined by the Secretary) by which—

"(i) the average monthly costs of tuition and
expenses for commuter students at public institutions of higher learning that award baccalaureate
degrees for purposes of paragraph (1) for the fiscal
year involved, exceeds

21 "(ii) such average monthly costs for the pre-22 ceding fiscal year.

"(B) The Secretary shall make the determination
under subparagraph (A) after consultation with the Secretary of Education.

"(C) A determination made under subparagraph (A)
 in a year shall take effect on October 1 of that year and
 apply with respect to basic educational assistance allow ances payable under this section for the fiscal year begin ning in that year.

6 "(D) Not later than September 30 each year, the Sec7 retary shall publish in the Federal Register the average
8 monthly costs of tuition and expenses as determined under
9 subparagraph (A) in that year.".

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—(1) Section
11 3015(h) of title 38, United States Code, is amended by
12 striking "by which—" and all that follows and inserting
13 "determined by the Secretary under section 16131(b)(2)
14 of title 10 for the fiscal year involved.".

15 (2) The amendment made by paragraph (1) shall16 apply to fiscal years beginning on or after October 1,17 2004.
