Mr. Paul introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Government Reform

A BILL

To disqualify certain persons from receiving Federal funds.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Truth in Financing
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DISQUALIFICATION FOR FEDERAL FUNDING.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any re-
- 8 cipient of Federal funds shall be disqualified for Federal
- 9 funding of any type if, at a time when the recipient is
- 10 receiving Federal funds for any of the recipient's activi-
- 11 ties, the recipient is found by any Federal agency or Fed-
- 12 eral or State court to have—

1	(1) made a false statement on an application
2	for Federal funds;
3	(2) violated any Federal law or regulation or
4	State or local law punishable by imprisonment for at
5	least 6 months or a fine of at least \$5,000; and
6	(3) aided or abetted the violation of any law or
7	regulation described in paragraph (2).
8	SEC. 3. CAUSE OF ACTION.
9	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, or any
10	judicial decision relating to issues of standing, any citizen
11	of the United States may bring a private cause of action
12	against any organization receiving Federal funds for vio-
13	lating the prohibition of section 2.
