A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of State to enter into negotiations with representatives of the Government of Cuba to establish cooperation between the United States and Cuba on illicit narcotics control efforts.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF
- 4 CUBA TO ESTABLISH COOPERATION ON IL-
- 5 LICIT NARCOTICS CONTROL EFFORTS.
- 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
- 7 retary of State (or the Secretary's designee) is authorized
- 8 to enter into negotiations with representatives of the Gov-

- 1 ernment of Cuba to establish cooperation between appro-
- 2 priate governmental agencies of the United States and
- 3 Cuba on illicit narcotics control efforts, including efforts
- 4 to provide increased cooperation, coordination, and assist-
- 5 ance between the two countries to interdict illicit narcotics
- 6 that are transported through the territory of Cuba (includ-
- 7 ing Cuban airspace and waters).
