- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. STATE OPTION TO TEMPORARILY EXTEND
- 4 WAIVER GRANTED WITH RESPECT TO THE
- 5 STATE PROGRAM OF AID TO FAMILIES WITH
- 6 **DEPENDENT CHILDREN.**
- 7 Section 415 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- 8 615) is amended by adding at the end the following:
- 9 "(e) STATE OPTION TO TEMPORARILY EXTEND
- 10 Waiver In Effect on Date of Enactment of Wel-

- 1 FARE REFORM.—A State that is operating under a waiver
- 2 described in subsection (a)(1)(A) which would otherwise
- 3 expire in the period that begins on January 1, 2002, and
- 4 ends on September 30, 2008, may elect to continue to op-
- 5 erate under the waiver, on the same terms and conditions
- 6 as applied to the waiver on the day before the date the
- 7 waiver would otherwise expire, through the earlier of such
- 8 date as the State may select or September 30, 2008.".
