3 **SECTION 1. PERMITTING COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF**
4 **COLUMBIA TO IMPOSE INCOME TAX ON VIS-**
5 **ITING PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL PLAYERS.**

6 Section 602(a)(5) of the District of Columbia Home
7 Rule Act (sec. 1–206.02(a)(5), D.C. Official Code) is
8 amended by striking “not a resident of the District” and

1 inserting the following: “not a resident of the District, ex-
2 cept that the Council may impose such a tax on such an
3 individual to the extent that the income is derived from
4 services rendered within the District as a member of a
5 professional baseball team”.
