A BILL

To provide that the language of the text of United States passports is written in English and Spanish.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LANGUAGE OF UNITED STATES PASSPORTS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 5 sion of law, the language of the text of all regular United
- 6 States passports shall be written in English and Spanish.
- 7 (b) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) shall take ef-
- 8 fect one year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
