A BILL

To amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to make private, nonprofit medical facilities that serve industry specific clients eligible for hazard mitigation and disaster assistance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 102(9) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster
4 Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5122(9))
5 is amended by striking the period at the end and inserting
6 the following: “and includes a facility that (A) provides
7 medical services to a specific occupational or industry seg-
8 ment of the general public, and (B) is operated by an or-

1 ganization described in subsection (c) or (d) of section 501
2 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (26 U.S.C. 501)
3 and exempt from taxation under subsection (a) of such
4 section.”.
