A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Bureau of Reclamation, to conduct a feasibility study of the Tualatin River Basin in Oregon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT FEASIBILITY**
4 **STUDY.**

5 (a) SHORT TITLE.— This section may be cited as the
6 “Tualatin River Basin Water Supply Enhancement Act of
7 2003”.

8 (b) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of the Interior,
9 acting through the Bureau of Reclamation, is authorized

1 to conduct a water supply feasibility study of the Tualatin
2 River Basin in Oregon in order to—

3 (1) identify ways to meet future water supply
4 needs for agriculture, municipal, and industrial uses;

5 (2) identify water conservation and storage
6 measures;

7 (3) identify measures that would improve water
8 quality and enable environmental and species protec-
9 tion; and

10 (4) where appropriate, evaluate integrated
11 water resource management and supply needs in the
12 Tualatin River Basin in Oregon.

13 (c) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of the
14 costs of the study authorized by this section shall not ex-
15 ceed 50 percent of the total, and shall be nonreimbursable
16 and nonreturnable.

17 (d) NO SUPPLEMENTAL OR ADDITIONAL BENEFIT.—
18 Activities funded under this Act shall not be considered
19 a supplemental or additional benefit under the Act of June
20 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388) and all Acts amendatory thereof
21 or supplementary thereto.

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
