Mr. WEINER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on International Relations

A BILL

To prohibit United States assistance for the Palestinian Authority and for programs, projects, and activities in the West Bank and Gaza.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON UNITED STATES ASSISTANCE**
4 **FOR THE PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY AND THE**
5 **WEST BANK AND GAZA.**

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, United
7 States assistance may not be provided directly or indi-
8 rectly to the Palestinian Authority (or to any successor
9 or related entity) or for programs, projects, and activities
10 in the West Bank or Gaza unless the President determines

1 and certifies to the Committee on International Relations
2 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
3 Foreign Relations of the Senate that—

4 (1) the leadership of the Palestinian Author-
5 ity—

6 (A) has publicly renounced violence as a
7 means of political expression; and

8 (B) has taken all actions within its capac-
9 ity to bring an end to the violence which com-
10 menced in early October 2000 in the West
11 Bank and Gaza; and

12 (2) the violence in the West Bank and Gaza has
13 subsided.
