## A BILL

For the relief of Frank Redendo.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

  SECTION 1. COMPENSATION FOR VACCINE-RELATED IN
  JURY.

  (a) WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATION.—The time limitation set forth in section 2116(a)(1) of the Public Health
- 7 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300aa–16(a)(1)) shall not apply
- 8 to a petition for compensation filed under section 2111
- 9 of that Act by Frank Redendo of Carmel, New York, for
- 10 injuries received as a result of a vaccine administered in
- 11 March, 1964.

- 1 (b) DEADLINE.—Subsection (a) shall apply only to
- 2 a petition filed not later than 2 years after the date of

3 the enactment of this Act.
