Mr. SCHROCK introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Transportation to issue a certificate of documentation with appropriate endorsement for employment in the coastwise trade for the vessel M/T MISS LINDA.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That notwithstanding section 27 of the Merchant Marine
4 Act, 1920 (46 App. U.S.C. 883) and section 12106 of title
5 46, United States Code, the Secretary of Transportation
6 may issue a certificate of documentation with appropriate
7 endorsement for employment in the coastwise trade for the
8 vessel M/T MISS LINDA, a steel hull tugboat that is 35

1 feet in length, was constructed in approximately 1929 at
2 the Bath Iron Works Shipyard in Bath, Maine, and is
3 owned on the date of the enactment of this Act by East
4 Bay Construction Corporation, located in Virginia Beach,
5 Virginia.
