## A BILL

To permit members of the House of Representatives to donate used computer equipment to public elementary and secondary schools designated by the members.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMITTING MEMBERS OF HOUSE OF REP-
- 4 RESENTATIVES TO DONATE USED COMPUTER
- 5 EQUIPMENT TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 104(a)(3) of the Legisla-
- 7 tive Branch Appropriations Act, 1987 (as incorporated by
- 8 reference in section 101(j) of Public Law 99–500 and

- 1 Public Law 99-591) (2 U.S.C. 117e(3)) is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 "(3)(A) At the request of a member of the House
- 4 of Representatives, in the case of equipment consisting of
- 5 computers and related peripheral tools previously used by
- 6 the member, the Clerk may donate the equipment to a
- 7 public elementary or secondary school (as defined in sec-
- 8 tion 9101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education
- 9 Act of 1965) without regard to whether the donation
- 10 meets the requirements of the second sentence of para-
- 11 graph (2).
- 12 "(B) At the request of the member who previously
- 13 used the equipment, if the Clerk donates equipment under
- 14 this paragraph, the Clerk shall donate the equipment to
- 15 a school designated by the member.".
- 16 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 17 subsection (a) shall take effect October 1, 2003.
