3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO TRADE SANCTIONS REFORM**
4 **AND EXPORT ENHANCEMENT ACT OF 2000.**

5 Section 908 of the Trade Sanctions Reform and Ex-
6 port Enhancement Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7207) is
7 amended—

8 (1) by striking subsection (b);

1 (2) in subsection (a)—

2 (A) by striking “PROHIBITION” and all
3 that follows through “(1) IN GENERAL.—” and
4 inserting “IN GENERAL.—”;

5 (B) by redesignating paragraph (2) as sub-
6 section (b) (and conforming the margin accord-
7 ingly); and

8 (C) by redesignating paragraph (3) as sub-
9 section (c) (and conforming the margin accord-
10 ingly);

11 (3) in subsection (b) (as redesignated), by strik-
12 ing “paragraph (1)” and inserting “subsection (a)”;
13 and

14 (4) in subsection (c) (as redesignated), by strik-
15 ing “paragraph (1)” and inserting “subsection (a)”.
