1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TIME PERIOD FOR FILING OF AN APPLICATION**

4 **FOR TEMPORARY LABOR CERTIFICATION.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in the
6 processing of alien labor certification applications for tem-
7 porary nonagricultural occupations, an application for a
8 temporary labor certification may be filed with the appro-

- 1 private employment agency serving the area of employment
- 2 not more than 180 days before workers are needed.
