## A BILL

To provide for grants to States for enacting statewide laws regulating public playgrounds consistent with playground safety guidelines established by the Consumer Product Safety Commission.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
- 4 This Act may be referred to as the "Safe Playgrounds
- 5 Act".

### SEC. 2. GRANT FOR ENACTING PLAYGROUND SAFETY

- 2 **STANDARDS.**
- 3 (a) In General.—Subject to the availability of ap-
- 4 propriations for this purpose, the Consumer Product Safe-
- 5 ty Commission shall provide a grant in the amount of
- 6 \$1,000,000 to any State which meets the requirements of
- 7 subsection (b).
- 8 (b) Eligibility.—A State is eligible for a grant
- 9 under subsection (a) if, not more than 5 years after the
- 10 date of enactment of this Act, such State has enacted a
- 11 statewide law regulating public playgrounds consistent
- 12 with the guidelines contained in the Handbook for Public
- 13 Playground Safety, published by the Consumer Product
- 14 Safety Commission, or other playground safety guidelines
- 15 established by the Commission.
- 16 (c) USE OF GRANT FUNDS.—A State receiving a
- 17 grant under this Act shall use the grant to upgrade public
- 18 playgrounds in accordance with the guidelines described
- 19 in subsection (b).

### 20 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- There are authorized to be appropriated to the Con-
- 22 sumer Product Safety Commission for carrying out this
- 23 Act \$50,000,000 for the period encompassing fiscal years
- 24 2004 through 2008.
