- 1 Park in Jersey City, New Jersey, to the New Jersey vic-
- 2 tims of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001.
- 3 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
- 4 There is authorized to be appropriated \$100,000 for
- 5 fiscal year 2004 for carrying out this Act, such sums to
- 6 remain available until expended.
