A BILL

To restore freedom of choice to women in the uniformed services serving outside the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Freedom of Choice
5 for Women in the Uniformed Services Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITING RESTRICTION OF USE OF DEPARTMENT**
2 **OF DEFENSE MEDICAL FACILITIES TO PER-**
3 **FORM ABORTIONS TO FACILITIES IN THE**
4 **UNITED STATES.**

5 Section 1093(b) of title 10, United States Code, is
6 amended by inserting “in the United States” after “De-
7 fense”.
