3 **SECTION 1. PERMITTING USE OF MEMBER'S REPRESENTA-**
4 **TIONAL ALLOWANCE TO PURCHASE POW/MIA**
5 **FLAGS FOR CONSTITUENTS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—A Member of the House of Rep-
7 resentatives may use amounts provided in the Member's
8 Representational Allowance to obtain POW/MIA flags and

3 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

4 (1) the term “Member” includes a Delegate or
