A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to reallocate costs of the Pactola Dam and Reservoir, South Dakota, to reflect increased demands for municipal and industrial and fish and wildlife purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pactola Reservoir Re-
5 allocation Authorization Act of 2003”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 The Congress finds the following:

1 (1) It is appropriate to reallocate the costs of
2 the Pactola Dam and Reservoir, South Dakota, to
3 reflect increased demands for municipal and indus-
4 trial and fish and wildlife purposes.

5 (2) Section 302 of the Department of Energy
6 Organization Act (42 U.S.C. 7152) prohibits this re-
7 allocation of costs without congressional approval.

8 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF REALLOCATION OF COSTS OF**
9 **PACTOLA DAM AND RESERVOIR, SOUTH DA-**
10 **KOTA.**

11 The Secretary of the Interior may reallocate the con-
12 struction costs of the Pactola Dam and Reservoir, Rapid
13 Valley Unit, Pick-Sloan Missouri Basin Program, South
14 Dakota, from irrigation purposes to municipal and indus-
15 trial and fish and wildlife purposes. The reallocation shall
16 be accomplished in a manner consistent with reclamation
17 law (including the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388),
18 and all Acts amendatory thereof or supplementary there-
19 to) and Bureau of Reclamation policy.
