A BILL

For the relief of Shwa-Chen Chai.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENTITLEMENT TO AN ALTERNATIVE FORM OF**
4 **ANNUITY.**

5 For purposes of any determination of rights under
6 subchapter III of chapter 83 of title 5, United States
7 Code, Dr. An-Ti Chai, the late husband of Shwa-Chen
8 Chai of Oberlin, Ohio, shall be deemed—

9 (1) to have been retired under section
10 8336(d)(2) of such title 5 at the time of his death;
11 and

1 (2) to have made an election of a lump-sum
2 payment under section 8343a of such title 5.
