2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “People’s Right to
5 Know Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF FOIA LIMITATION.**

7 Section 644 of the Treasury and General Government
8 Appropriations Act, 2003 (Public Law 108–7, div. J) is
9 repealed.
