- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Dental Officer Reten-
- 5 tion Act".

SEC. 2. REPEAL OF LIMITATION ON RECEIPT OF SPECIAL 2 PAY BY DENTAL OFFICERS. Section 302b of title 37, United States Code, is 3 4 amended— (1) in subsection (a)(4), by striking "for any 5 6 12-month period during which the officer is not un-7 dergoing dental internship or residency training. Such additional special pay shall be paid"; and 8 (2) in subsection (b)(1), by striking "for any 9 12-month period". 10
