To extend for an additional six months the period for which
chapter 12 of title 11 of the United States Code is reenacted.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protection of Family
5 Farmers Act of 2003”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL SIX-MONTH EXTENSION OF PERIOD**

7 **FOR WHICH CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 11,**

8 **UNITED STATES CODE, IS REENACTED.**

9 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 149 of title I of division
10 C of Public Law 105–277 (11 U.S.C. 1201 note), as most

1 recently amended by section 2 of Public Law 107–377
2 (116 Stat. 3115), is further amended—

3 (1) by striking “July 1, 2003” each place it ap-
4 pears and inserting “January 1, 2004”; and

5 (2) in subsection (a)—

6 (A) by striking “December 31, 2002” and
7 inserting “June 30, 2003”; and

8 (B) by striking “January 1, 2003” and in-
9 serting “July 1, 2003”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
11 subsection (a) shall take effect as of July 1, 2003.
